- School fees and charges are payable by term in advance by standing order to the school bank account. **There are three terms per academic year.** Fees are due on 10thSeptember, 2ndJanuary and 1stApril.
- There is a reduction of 20%, on tuition only, for the third and any following child in the same family.
- The **application fee (and resources)** for admission is **€590 per year.** This amount is used to pay for books and supplies and the cost of transport for excursions within city limits.
- **An additional charge of €950 per child** will be made to **new families, as a deposit.** This will be deducted, in its entirety, from the first invoice in September.

Notes:

1. No refund of school fees or charges will be made in case of absence, illness, withdrawal or dismissal.
2. An annual re-enrolment fee (*'application fee' and resources*) is charged in the Spring term to guarantee the pupil's place for the following academic year. This fee includes the books, resources, trips within the city limits and supplies for the next academic year. Parents of pupils intending to leave the school in June must send in written confirmation of their departure before the end of the first term. No refund will be made if notice of departure is given after this date.
3. Pupils joining the school are charged a deposit of €950 per pupil, payable on acceptance of a place at the school. **THIS AMOUNT WILL BE DEDUCTED, IN ITS ENTIRETY**, from the first invoice in September. No reimbursement, however, will be made in case of cancellation.
4. If for any reason a pupil receives education elsewhere for one term or more, but intends to return to ISM, then the tuition fee for that period must be paid in full in order to guarantee the place when the pupil returns to the school. If the tuition fee for this period of absence is not paid, the place will be considered available and offered to the next child on the waiting list.
5. An additional charge is made for external examinations, including National Curriculum Tests in Year 6, Cambridge International English exams, IGCSE and A-Levels. The corresponding amounts are included on the termly bill where applicable.
6. School lunches are compulsory for all pupils. Packed lunches are not permitted.
7. The parent/guardian of any child who is accepted on the condition that they must have extra classes in order to reach the required level, will need to meet the costs of these, by arrangement.

A BUS SERVICE is available, by arrangement.
