## Important Notes - please be sure you understand:

- 1. School fees and charges are payable by term in advance by standing order to the school bank account. There are three terms per academic year. Fees are due on 10<sup>th</sup> September, 2<sup>nd</sup> January and 1<sup>st</sup> April.
- 2. No refund of school fees or charges will be made in case of absence, illness, withdrawal or dismissal.
- 3. An annual re-enrolment fee is charged in February to guarantee a pupil's place for the following academic year. Parents of pupils intending to leave the school must send in written confirmation of their departure by the end of January. No refund will be made if payment has been made and notice of departure is given after this date.
- 4. Pupils joining the school are charged a deposit of €990 per pupil, payable on acceptance of a place at the school. **THIS AMOUNT WILL BE DEDUCTED, IN ITS ENTIRETY**, from the first invoice in September. No reimbursement, however, will be made in case of cancellation.
- 5. If for any reason a pupil receives education elsewhere for one term or more, but intends to return to ISM, then the tuition fee for that period must be paid in full in order to guarantee the place when the pupil returns to the school. If the tuition fee for this period of absence is not paid, the place will be considered available and offered to the next child on the waiting list.
- 6. An additional charge is made for external examinations, including Cambridge International English exams, IGCSE and A-Levels. The corresponding amounts are included on the termly bill, where applicable.
- 7. School lunches are compulsory for all pupils. Packed lunches are not permitted.
- 8. The parent/guardian of any child who is accepted on the condition that they must have English language immersion classes in order to reach the required level, will need to meet the costs of these, by arrangement.
